Dress Code

On the golf course and practice facilities

Recognised golf attire, including golf shoes, should be worn at all times. Shorts should be tailored and worn with sports socks.

Examples of unacceptable attire:

- Casual “T” shirts
- Denim Jeans
- Collarless shirts (unless recognised golf attire)
- Football or rugby tops/shorts
- Track suits
- Caps worn back to front
- Shirts worn outside trousers/shorts/skirts (unless designed to be worn as such).
- Trousers tucked inside socks (unless underneath waterproofs)
- Beach/Swim shorts

In the clubhouse

Patrons are required to be dressed in clean, smart clothing and shoes at all times. Clothing which has been worn on the golf course immediately prior is acceptable providing it is neither wet nor soiled.

Examples of unacceptable attire:

- As above under “golf course”, plus:
- Outdoor clothing
- Golfing waterproofs.
- Golf shoes (other than in locker-rooms)
- Trainers
- Caps, skips etc.

In the Car Park

The changing of clothing or footwear is not permitted in the car park, unless the clubhouse is closed.

Clubhouse staff, General Committee members, and the Club Professional and his Assistants have discretion on the acceptability of dress.

Mobile Phones

As a courtesy to other members, guests and visitors, the use of mobile phones should be discreet at all times. In particular, ring tones should be switched to “silent” within the clubhouse and on the golf course, and calls should not be taken or made on the golf course, or in the clubhouse lounges, unless in an emergency.
